CHILLI CHOCOLATE CAKE

David, Elizabeth - French Provincial Cooking

100g best quality cooking chocolate
2 tablespoons plain flour
100g caster sugar

90g unsalted butter, softened
½ teaspoon chilli powder
3 eggs, separated

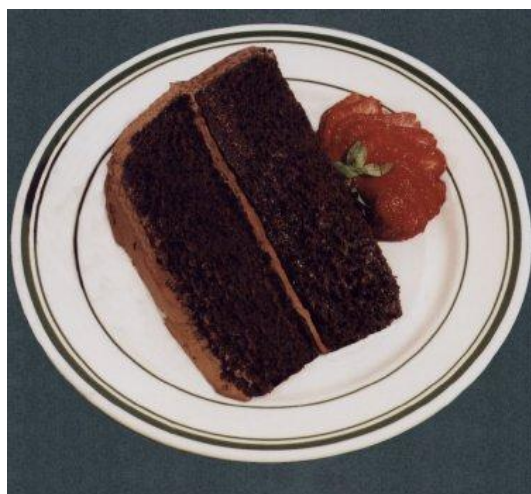
Preheat oven to 180°C.

Gently melt the chocolate in the oven, microwave or in a heat-proof bowl suspended over simmering water. Mix the chocolate with the softened butter, flour, chilli powder, sugar and lightly beaten egg yolks. Beat the egg whites until soft peaks form. Fold the egg whites into the chocolate mixture.

Turn the cake mixture into a buttered loaf tin (approximately 20cm x 10 cm) and bake in pre-heated oven for 35 minutes. The cake will be cooked when a thin crust has formed on top. It may appear slightly under-cooked inside, however it will become firmer as it cools. The ultimate result is a moist, dense cake with a crackly exterior.

Turn out onto cake rack as soon as it is cooled.

Note: can be made without the Chilli powder to be just a chocolate cake (boring)
