With Easter just around the corner here is a Hot Cross Bun recipe:

HOT CROSS BUNS
Makes 16 Preparation 40 minutes (plus proving)
Cooking 25 minutes

2 x 7g sachets dry yeast (or 30g fresh)
 300ml milk, warmed
 4½ cups plain flour
 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
 90g butter, chopped
 1½ cups mixed dried fruit
 ¼ cup caster sugar
 1 egg
 4-5 tablespoons water

GLAZE
 ¼ cup water
 ¼ cup sugar
 1 teaspoon mixed spice

1. Sprinkle yeast over milk in a jug. Set aside for 5 minutes until foamy. Sift 4 cups flour and cinnamon into a bowl. Rub in butter with fingertips. Stir in fruit and sugar.
2. Whisk egg into milk mixture. Add to flour, mix to a soft dough. Knead on a lightly floured board until smooth and elastic. Place in a lightly greased bowl, cover and set aside in a warm place until doubled in size (known as proving).
3. Preheat oven to very hot, 220°C. Punch dough down with fist to release gas. Divide into 16 pieces. Knead each into rounds. Place close together on greased tray. Set aside, covered, until doubled in size. Combine remaining flour with water to form a paste. Use to pipe crosses onto buns. Bake 10 minutes. Reduce oven to hot, 200°C. Bake 10-12 minutes.
4. **GLAZE.** Simmer all ingredients 3-4 minutes, without stirring. Brush over hot buns. Transfer to a wire rack to cool. Serve warm with butter.

 8 Tiny Teddy biscuits
 8 mini Milky Way bars
 Smarties
 M&M minis
 4 Lifesaver lollies

- 1 Place the sifted icing sugar in a bowl and stir in enough water to give a spreadable consistency.
- 2 Referring to picture, insert

Tiny Teddy biscuits into the Milky Way bars, then use a little of the icing to stick four Smarties onto each car for wheels, two M&M minis for headlights and a halved Lifesaver for the steering wheel. Allow the icing to set.
