## ***VALE - DOLLY CRUIKSHANK***

### ***LAWGI Indoor Bowls Club CALLIDE VALLEY INDOOR BOWLS ASSOCIATION***

Dorothy Ella Woodford was born on the 12<sup>th</sup> September 1920 in Munduberra. Eleventh child of Sam and Chatharina Woodford. Dolly's eldest sister died leaving 3 small children and these children were also brought up by Dolly's parents.

Dolly only went to school for a few years at Kapaldo near Monto, then home to the farm to help her aging parents. When they were shelling corn by hand Dolly's brothers and sisters would also be playing a form of poker called gin rummy with the corn kernels as money. Hand milking the cows and having milk fights was great fun.

Dolly went to a dance at Dawes Hall and there she met Grant Cruikshank, home from war with injuries. A long distance courtship began. Many letters and telegrams followed. 100 miles was a long way in those days. Dolly married Grant in 1944 and moved into a little car shed with a stove recess for a home.

A new house was built and then the three children arrived, Robin arrived first, followed by two girls.

A big celebration was held on New Years Eve in Dolly and Grants home. This celebration became so big that when the Lawgi Hall was built the festivities were transferred to the hall.

Dolly was a great cook, specializing in plum puddings and sponges. Sewing was never a bother. Craft was a pastime she enjoyed especially tapestry. Dolly's front garden was a picture of colour with every type of Gerbera available.

Some local people were traveling and came across this game called indoor bowls. A mat and some bowls were purchased and in 1959 the Lawgi Indoor Bowls Club was formed. Friday nights were reserved for Indoor Bowls, Thursday afternoons Outdoor Bowls. Dolly was secretary of Lawgi Club for over 40 years. When Grant started playing Outdoor Bowls as well, it was nearly a draw of straws for the use of the car. Dolly was very involved with the running of Ladies Bowls and she became President for a term.

Robin married Jenny and they started having children. Dolly was always on hand to mind the kids so that Robin and Jenny could go to bowls all around Queensland and the East Coast.

When the Indoor Bowlers started hiring Christenssens Coaches to go to the National Titles Dolly volunteered to make the biscuits. She made tins of Monte Carlos, Iced Anzac Biscuits, Jam Drops and Ginger Nuts. On many a cold morning, morning tea with hot coffee and Nana's biscuits were had.

Dolly had a heart attack and Grant was aging so they moved into the Retirement Village in Biloela on twenty-ninth April 2005. Grant sadly passed on in the same year and Dolly passed away on the twenty-ninth April 2011.

## ATTENTION ALL KNITTERS WHO WOULD LIKE SOMETHING TO DO WITH ALL YOUR EXCESS WOOL.

There are currently 1.9 million orphaned or vulnerable children living in South Africa There is a group who organise the distribution a Beanies and Squares to help these people.



### **Beanies for Babies.**

You will need:

1 ball 8 ply or DK yarn

1 pair 5mm needles

Tapestry needle for sewing up.

### **Here's How:**

Cast on 90 sts.

Row 1: (k2, p2) to end of row.

Row 2: (p2, k2) to end of row.

These 2 rows form the double rib pattern.

Continue in double rib pattern until work measures 10cm from the start.

Change to single rib pattern as follows (or see Stocking stitch variation below)

Row 1: (right side): (k1, p1) to end of row.

Row 2: Knit to end of row.

Row 3: (k1, p1) to end of row.

Row 4: (k8, k2 tog) to end of row....81 sts.

Row 5: (k1, p1) to end of row.

Row 6: (k7, k2 tog) to end of row .....72 sts.

Row 7: (and rows 9, 11, 13, 15, 17): (k1, p1)to end of row.

Row 8: (k6, k2 tog) to end of row ....63 sts

Row 10: (k5, k2 tog) to end of row ....54 sts.

Row 12: (k4, k2 tog) to end of row ....45 sts.

Row 14: (k3, k2 tog) to end of row ....36 sts.

Row 16: (k2, k2 tog) to end of row ....27 sts.

Row 18: (k1, k2 tog) to end of row ....18 sts.

Repeat row 18 until only 1 stitch remains.

Cast off, leaving a long tail of yarn for sewing up.

### **Stocking stitch variation**

At the end of the double rib pattern, work every odd numbered row in purl instead of rib. Row 1 is wrong side.

### **To Make Up.**

With right sides together, sew the centre back seam from top to bottom, using a flat seam for the double rib section, so the cuff can be turned back.

**TIP: This knitted hat can be increased or decreased in size by using different sized yarn and/or needles, from 3.5mm to 7mm. All sizes are welcome.**
