From our Kiwi Neighbors!

I asked Carmel to write something for me as I played with her and her son for a few years when I lived in Christchurch. Carmel is the secretary for Canterbury Indoor Bowls. She was there first had when the earth quake struck which devastated the bowling community.

I started indoor bowls in 1972 while I was still at primary school and have served on indoor bowls committees since. I have been President of the NZ Catholic Indoor Bowls Federation, Canterbury Catholic Indoor Bowls Association and currently doing about my fifth term as President of my club. I met my late husband through indoor bowls and have two children Nicole and James who also play the game however my daughter is having time off since giving birth to triplet sons last year. My son won his second South Island title last year and was selected in the South Island team where he won a medal in the Triples. I also have four siblings who play the game so there is much rivalry one of them, Kevin Anngow has played for New Zealand back in the late 1990s. Indoor bowls is a great game than can be played by all ages, which can be a great leveler.

The Canterbury Earthquakes have been a real setback for me and my family, with 3 generations of us losing our houses in the devastating quakes along with others needing to have major repairs done. We also lost our local parish church.

Along with this, being employed by Canterbury Indoor Bowls their premises had over \$1m worth of damage so my office had to be relocated to my home in the red zone and then when I moved from there it was another shift for the office. Working from home has its advantages and disadvantages. One advantage is being able to have glide time.

INDOOR BOWLING



Another huge blow for Canterbury Indoor bowls was a fire at the Bowls Stadium in Kearneys Rd on 19th September last year, where we lost the Offices, kitchen, dining, lounge, bar and meeting areas along with both the men's and women's toilet blocks. For safety reasons these areas had to be immediately demolished. This is a huge setback as the building was on schedule to reopen for our 2015 season for the first time since the earthquakes. Now we are planning ahead for a 2016 reopening following a major repair.

I am fortunate enough to be able to travel to various Indoor Bowls Tournaments and enjoy playing in the Catholic Nationals on a regular basis, and also the National Champs. I am a Life Member of my club St Pauls who had only shifted to the Canterbury Indoor Bowls Hall as the club venue the season prior to the major quake so that was another problem to work through. As President of our Club this was sorted and we are grateful to Woolston Working Mens Club for allowing our club to use their premises on weekly club nights.

Life goes on, it hasn't been easy and there have been lots of difficult times, but now we have to look forward to the future. I am so glad I have so many great friends in our sport who have been very supportive during these difficult times. It is great to have something to look forward to and having planned trips away to indoor bowls been great, there is always a trip in the planning stages.

I have been asked to do a player profile on a couple of people already. At this stage I have not been able to get it completed. As it will not fit in this issue. I will ensure I have it completed for the next issue out in time for the October Titles.

Umpires Corner



Skip's Rule

Don't forget – the skip is there for a reason. If they ask for a shot, they will have a reason for it. Bowls is a mind game so they will be trying to build a head the best way they can use it. If you really can't see a shot, let them know. If you still don't see it and they want you to still play the shot they called, give it your all. As long as you try your best nobody will hold that against you.

<u>Using the Matt / Box</u>

Don't forget – your feet can not be on the matt when you bowl (including your big toe ©)

Your bowl must also be delivered out the front of the box and not the side.

Stepping onto the Matt

With nationals coming up, and the refresher at the first team trial. Players cannot go up to the head unless asked by the skip. Feel free to let them know you want to look, but until they call you up, you must stay back, it is the same for the third when the skip is bowling. The Third cannot get onto the mat to let the skip know what is going on – eg who has shot, or what to play – unless the skip has asked first.

<u>Time Limit</u>

Don't forget, there is a one minute time limit for you to deliver your bowl after the last bowl has come to rest. That's plenty of time for the skip to call you up, have a look and get back to play. If you are concerned, try timing yourself the next time you play ©
