A Players Point of View



I woke up at 3am!!! TWO HOURS before I needed to leave home and head to work where I would park and then train to the airport and meet Sheree and Ross Lowry. By this point looking around there were some nervous faces – I was one of them not expecting to get in – there were amazing bowls being played all around and anybody could have been picked.

Then the names were read, we got to David and Carmel, then I was skipping the Triples...I missed what else I was playing in at this point. Then we got to Haydn – he was in my team and George who had played three games with over the weekend, then onto Ryan who was named as reserve. Unfortunately Shorty and Sheree were not named in the team – they had both played great all weekend though.

This is the same at state level. Some people worry about playing David Blyth, Errol Weir, or Jody Moore, etc but embrace the challenge it's a chance to test where you are at and see what you need to work on.

No matter how good you can be – there will always somebody better and anybody can lose!

I want to thank all the players that were selected to trial for the team and to Kaylene Weir and Ross Lowry who gave us all immense support while we were there, keeping spirits up when we were doubting things a little at times. We may go head to head and try to smash each other when playing but down there we were family all supporting each other, so I just want to say a big thank to Kaylene, Errol, Haydn, Ross, Sheree, Shorty, Carmel, David and Ryan.
