This is a recipe for the very best **sugar cookies** you'll ever make. Be sure to read entire recipe, most especially the notes at the bottom, before making these cookies.

Prep Time: 3 hours, 25 minutes

Cook Time: 8 minutes

Total Time: 3 hours, 33 minutes

Ingredients:

1-1/2 cups sugar	2/3 cup shortening or butter*	2 eggs
2 tablespoons milk	teaspoon vanilla extract	3-1/4 cups flour
1/2 teaspoons baking powder	1/2 teaspoon salt	

Preparation:

Early in the day or the day before: In a large bowl cream the shortening and the sugar. Add the eggs, extract, and milk. In a medium bowl mix the dry ingredients with a wire whisk. Add the dry ingredients to the large bowl. Mix with mixer until well combined. With hands, shape dough into a ball. Wrap with plastic wrap and refrigerate for 2 to 3 hours. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Lightly grease cookie sheets. Roll** half or 1/3 dough at a time, keep the rest refrigerated. For crisp cookies, roll dough, paper thin. For softer cookies, roll 1/8 " to 1/4" thick. With floured cookie cutter, cut into shapes. Re-roll trimmings and cut. Place cookies 1/2 inch apart on cookie sheets. Decorate*** Bake 8 minutes or until very light brown. With pancake turner, remove cookies to racks; cool. Makes about 6 dozen cookies.



Kids of all ages love **Snickerdoodles**.

Prep Time: 30 minutes

Cook Time: 10 minutes

Total Time: 40 minutes

Ingredients:

cup shortening	1-1/2 cup sugar
2 eggs	2 3/4 cups flour
2 teaspoons cream of tartar	1 teaspoon soda
1/4 teaspoon salt	

Preparation:

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Lightly grease your cookie sheet. In a large bowl, cream shortening and sugar. Add eggs, one at a time. In a small bowl, combine flour, cream of tartar, soda and salt using a wire whisk. Gradually add flour mixture to shortening mixture until completely combined. Roll dough into balls about the size of walnuts. Dip into cinnamon sugar mixture. Bake two inched apart for 8 to 10 minutes. Makes about 3 dozen cookies.
