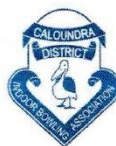

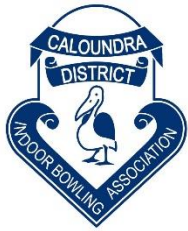

We Remember



In Loving Memory of

James Douglas Salmon



“Jim”

Born 9th June 1924

Passed away 19th March 2016

Aged 91 Years.

Jim was a well-respected bowler. His first Nationals was in 1984, in Adelaide, as a member of the Men's Fours. Jim then went on to represent Queensland at the Nationals for the next 22 years.

Jim passed away peacefully in Gympie.

He will be sadly missed by his family and his bowling friends.

Rex Brown



Rex was born in Killarney on the 13th February 1933 He was the the fifth child of Agnes and Herbert Brown. His siblings were Phyllis, Roy, Arnold, Daphne and Betty.

The family lived on a farm at Old Koreelah until Rex was 12 years old. To attend school while he lived there he was picked up by the truck that did the cream delivery around the district. Another fond memory of Rex's was watching the logs being loaded on to a train by bullocks at Killarney.

With a large family more land was required to feed the family so they rented a neighbours property while he was away at war. Then when the war ended the family required their property back which then forced the decision for Rex's family to move to the property at Victoria Hill in 1946, which is now managed by Chris.

When they moved to the dairy farm they milked 20 cows. Rex remembered milking 3 or 4 cows prior to catching the horse and riding to the Victoria Hill School. At this time Roy was breaking in horses and Rex rode them to school to exercise them however, one horse had Rex bluffed and he didn't want to ride it, so big brother Roy told him "get on that bloody horse and ride or I'll get the whip to you." I guess he did what he was told!

For many years the family farm was worked as a partnership between Rex and his brother Arnold. Prior to transport trucks Rex and Arnold used to drive cattle on foot to Donovan's Saleyards in Allora from the home property. They then purchased a 1942 Ford Truck, this enabled them to be one of the first people to do contract cattle cartage as well as delivering petrol around the district.



In 1952 at age 19 Rex entered the National Service for 2 years with 3 months training at Wacol. One of Rex's tales of misbehaviour was going AWOL one night with the Sergeant Major. It was at the Sergeant's suggestion that they had to have a night out before they went home, so they went out on the town and returned to the sergeant's quarters where they continued to drink rum and smoke his pipe. Hence to say from then on Rex never had another mouthful of rum.

In 1956 Rex married Evelyn Ruhle and had one Daughter Dianne. In 1963 Evelyn passed away after a short illness.

During Rex's enjoyment of tennis a new romance with Bev began and in 1966 they were married, followed by the arrival of four children Kerry, Chris, Sheree and Scott. Due to an unfortunate accident we sadly said goodbye to Kerry in 1975.

In 1981 the partnership with Arnold was dissolved whereby Rex and Bev decided to expand the dairy herd. They then commenced the Hillside Lodge Holstein Friesian Stud and spent many years showing and breeding cattle. Rex's favourite cow was Glamour and she won her class at the Queensland Feature Show in 1990.

Rex had a love for playing Cricket, Tennis and Indoor Bowls. During his cricket career Rex was a medium paced bowler and tells of taking 8 wickets for 26 runs.

Rex was a foundation member of the Victoria Hill Indoor Bowls Club formed in 1954. Through the next 60 years of bowling he won many shield nights, pairs and single championships with the highlight being selected into the Queensland Team in 2013. The following year Rex and Bev played for Queensland in Mt. Gambier. Illness prevented Rex from playing the following year.



Rex was a keen Broncos supporter and loved nothing more than sitting in his member seat at the footy and cheering his team on. On a few occasions he was even spotted on the TV in his supporters gear at the games.

Rex was a true country gentleman. He was a kind, quiet gentle man who never spoke out of turn or had a negative thing to say about anyone. Anybody that knew him would all say how quiet he was and never complained.

Rex is survived by wife Bev, children Dianne, Chris, Sheree and Scott as well as 10 grand children and 5 great grandchildren.

RIP Grandad and Little Great Grand Dad.
